Under ORS 36.405 the presiding judge of a judicial district may exempt or remove cases from arbitration under ORS 36.400 to 36.425, if in the opinion of the presiding judge good cause exists for such exemption or removal;

It is hereby ordered that if both parties to a case request that a case be exempted from arbitration, good cause may exist for such exemption or removal;

It is hereby further ordered that if the parties and arbitrator cannot agree on an arbitration hearing date so that all steps in the arbitration process set forth in UTCR chapter 13 are completed at least 30 days prior to the trial date set for the case by the court, good cause shall exist to remove the case from arbitration;

It is hereby further ordered that the presiding judge may exempt or remove a case from arbitration for other good cause shown.
