This Matter Coming Before the Court on its Own Motion:


Whereas ORS 161.566(3) allows the court to enter a default judgment against the defendant who fails to appear when a prosecuting attorney elects to treat a misdemeanor as a Class A Violation.

Whereas ORS 161.566(3) allows the court to impose a fine up to the maximum fine allowable for the class of misdemeanor receiving violation treatment.

IT IS THEREBY ORDERED that the maximum fine to be imposed in these matters, unless a Judge has good cause to deviate, shall be the Maximum Fine imposed for a Class C Misdemeanor under ORS 161.635(1) plus the Unitary Assessment called for under ORS 137.290.

It is further ordered that the Trial Court Administrator shall develop and implement procedures to carry out the purpose of this order.
