
GENERAL ORDER NO. 95-05

This matter having come before the court on its own motion under ORS 161.565(2) and the court wanting to establish a uniform policy for the treatment of misdemeanors as violations if the state fails to affirmatively state a case shall proceed as a misdemeanor;

It is hereby ordered that when a person appears for a first appearance on an accusatory instrument charging the person with a misdemeanor, the court shall treat the charge as a violation unless the state through one of its attorneys appears at the first appearance and affirmatively states that the case shall proceed as a misdemeanor or makes a notation on the accusatory instrument before the first appearance that the case shall proceed as a misdemeanor.

It is hereby ordered that this order takes effect immediately.
