This matter coming before the Court on its own motion:

WHEREAS, the FIAS Users Manual establishes the following guidelines on what is necessary in a Judgment to have a Joint and Several obligation:

1. A defendant should be ordered to pay Jointly and Severally in the judgment to have a Joint and Several Obligation; and
2. All Joint and Several defendants' names and case numbers should be listed in each judgment.

WHEREAS, defendants involved in the same cases may be sentenced at various times by different Judges.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

When a Judge signs a Judgment Order identifying various defendants as being responsible for Joint and Several Restitution to the same victim on the same case it is to be entered as such on each defendants case even if his/her original judgment for restitution does not say Joint and Severally.
