

TRIAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR ) NO. 2014-10

Under ORS 1.171(3) the presiding judge has the authority to delegate the exercise of administrative powers to the trial court administrator whose has duties specified in ORS 8.225, and the presiding judge having determined that the trial court administrator should have all necessary administrative power to perform the duties specified in ORS 8.225, and all necessary administrative power relating to non-judicial personnel, including judicial assistants, who are employees of the Oregon Judicial Department working for the Fifteenth Judicial District;

It is hereby ordered that the trial court administrator for the Fifteenth Judicial District shall have all necessary administrative powers to perform the duties specified under ORS 8.225, and all necessary administrative powers relating to the non-judicial personnel, including judicial assistants, who are employees of the Oregon Judicial Department working for the Fifteenth Judicial District:

It is hereby further ordered that the trial court administrator in performing the duties set forth in the preceding paragraph shall consult with the presiding judge.
