Under ORS 10.105 the presiding judge of a judicial district must set the length of jury service terms for the judicial district and the Fifteenth Judicial District consists of two counties, Coos and Curry, which have different jury service terms:

It is hereby order that there are two jury service terms for Coos County, consisting of the first of the each month to the second Friday after the first day of the of term of service and from the day following the second Friday until the end of each month for each month of the year;

It is hereby further ordered the jury service term for Curry County is the first full two weeks of each month of the year;

It is further ordered that the court may add additional jury service terms as is necessary to conduct court business.
