ORS 3.235 requires that the presiding judge of a judicial district set the terms of the circuit court for a judicial district and if there are two or more counties within a judicial district, the presiding judge shall set the terms of court for each county within the district and the Fifteenth Judicial District has two counties, Coos and Curry, within its boundaries with two places in Coos County, Coquille and North Bend, and one place in Curry County, Gold Beach, having matters heard at said locations:

It is hereby ordered that the terms of court for Coos and Curry Counties at each location at which judicial matters are heard shall be set to begin January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and end on July 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, and begin August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and end December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.

It is hereby further ordered that any and all judicial business not completed within one term of court shall be continued over to the next term of court, including from year to year.
