This matter having come before the court at the request of Paul Frasier, District Attorney for Coos County, Oregon, regarding discovery of personal identifiers of victims of crime as defined in ORS 135.815(5)(a), and the court finding that ORS 135.815(3)(a) prohibits the District Attorney from disclosing personal identifiers of victims to crimes to unrepresented defendants without a court order and that ORS 135.815(4)(a) prohibits a lawyer or the lawyer's representative from disclosing personal identifiers of victims of crimes to a defendant without a court order, and that each subsection provides how an unrepresented defendant or a lawyer for a defendant may request that such personal identifiers be disclosed:

It is hereby ordered that in all criminal cases filed in the Fifteenth Judicial District that crime victims' personal identifiers as defined in ORS 135.815(5)(a) shall not be disclosed by the District Attorney to an unrepresented defendant unless the defendant files a motion with the court and the court makes the findings required by ORS 135.815(3)(b);

It is further ordered that in all criminal cases filed in the Fifteenth Judicial District that a lawyer or a lawyer's representative cannot disclose crime victim's personal identifiers as defined in ORS 135.815(5)(a) to a defendant unless the defendant's attorney files a motion with the court and the court makes the findings required by ORS 135.815(4)(b);

It is hereby further ordered that this order takes effect on the date below.
