This matter coming before the court on its own motion;

It appearing to the court that from time to time defendants who are cited into court by citations for violations or infractions fail to appear.

It further appearing to the court that statute (ORS 133.067 and 153.190) sets out the court's authority to impose a fine upon the defendants who failure to appear.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

When a defendant fails to appear or post bail on a citation for a violation or infraction the Trial Court Administrator shall cause judgment for the statutory maximum fine to be entered against the defendant. The administrator shall mail notice of the fine imposed and a demand for payment to the defendant at the address on the citation. Further, the administrator shall take action to collect the fine.

It is further ordered that the Trial Court Administrator shall develop and implement procedures to carry out the purpose of this order.
