GENERAL ORDER
No. 94-01

This matter coming before the court on its own motion;

It appearing to the court that from time to time outstanding warrants need to be purged.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Warrants will be purged on a regular basis, excluding the charge of Murder. Warrants on felony sex cases will be purged six years from the date of issue and four years on misdemeanor sex cases. All other warrants will be purged after three years from date of issue for felony charges and two years for misdemeanor charges.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED:

If the defendant's probation period has not expired the above time limits will begin at the court ordered probation expiration date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the Trial Court Administrator shall develop and implement procedures to carry out the purpose of this order.
