TO ADULT COURTS)	

Whereas this Court has heretofore, on September 21, 1978, by General Order #8 made a blanket remand of all non-felony game/boating cases 16 years or older to adult court and whereas, the Court believes that it is appropriate for misdemeanor/felony offenses to be dealt with in the juvenile justice system due to options that may not be available to the adult courts:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED AND ORDERED:

1. Pursuant to ORS 419.533(5) all cases involving a violation of a law or ordinance relating to a game/boating law by a juvenile shall be remanded to the appropriate criminal or municipal court subject to conditions hereinafter set forth.

2. Those cases involving a violation of a law or ordinance relating to game/boating laws by a juvenile involving:

- 1. a misdemeanor
- 2. a felony

shall be referred to the Juvenile Department for hearing by the Juvenile Court.

3. Prior to hearing a case in which the defendant is under the age of 18, the receiving court shall notify the juvenile court of that fact. Such notice may be accomplished by furnishing of the citation/complaint to the Juvenile Department.

4. This order shall be effective November 4, 1992 and shall supersede and rescind Amended General Order #5 Amendment #3 filed December 21, 1984.
