GENERAL ORDER - 06-02

Pursuant to the above 2005 Oregon Laws the following individuals are appointed to the Coos Advisory Committee on Court Security and Emergency Preparedness:



The committee shall meet as called by Judge Gillespie. The Committee shall draft and submit for approval to the presiding judge a plan for court security, emergency preparedness and business continuity as described in chapter 804, Oregon Laws 2005. The committee shall also review, revise and amend each plan, as needed, no later than June 30th of each odd numbered year.
