This matter coming before the court on its own motion it appearing to the court that exhibits of one kind or another are offered at trial,

Sensitive exhibits shall include drugs and drug paraphernalia, guns, other weapons, money, jewelry and any other exhibits designated as sensitive by the Court. Sensitive exhibits are released to the investigating agency after the appeal period.

All non-sensitive exhibits taken into the court's custody shall be destroyed six weeks from the date of final judgment unless an appeal has been filed. Litigants may retrieve exhibits held by the court by notifying the exhibit clerk in writing of their intention before the six weeks have expired.

The previous General Order dated September 10, 1991 is set aside.
