**OREGON ECOURT FINAL GO LIVE EVENT  
RESTRICTIONS ON ACCESS**

The last 8 counties to have Odyssey installed (Baker, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Morrow, Umatilla, Union and Wallowa) will “go live” on Monday, June 6, 2016. You will be able to see on line case information for those counties beginning June 20, 2016.

To complete this process the following restrictions on access for Linn County will occur:

From Friday, June 3, 2016 at noon until Monday, June 6, 2016 at 8:00 AM Odyssey will not function in Oregon. Dockets on the afternoon of June 3 are being restricted to only essential matters. There will be no dependency docket on June 3.

On line access to OECI data and documents will not be available from Noon on Friday, June 3 until 8:00 AM on Wednesday, June 8, 2016. This includes access to on line calendars.

As a side note, on June 3 the last active OJIN system will shut down. It will continue to run in the background for conversion purposes but will no longer be available for current operations. After 32 years OJIN will come to an end.

Once this conversion is complete in eastern Oregon in June all of our courts in Oregon will be on one unified and integrated system with Odyssey internally and OECI externally. You will have access to court calendars and documents state wide from then on.

Thank you for your patience with this process, it started with Yamhill County in June 2012 and has taken four years. Linn County converted in December 2012.

You may now obtain access via the internet to Odyssey for Linn County (as well as many other counties) by going to <http://courts.oregon.gov/ojd/Pages/index.aspx> , clicking the box at right labeled OJIN On Line and you can sign up for access to Odyssey. You will have to establish a user identity and password. If you are already an OJIN on line subscriber you do not need to sign up a second time for that. The name for this new access system is OECI which stands for Oregon eCourt Case Information.

There is a charge for public access and you will learn about that charge when you go through the sign up process. If you have questions you may call the Help-Desk at 800-922-7391. Members of the public may still view case records in the courthouse at the window in Room 107 without charge, however if hard copies are requested they will cost 25 cents per page.
