

1 The undersigned shall not permit the recording(s) to be copied, reproduced, borrowed,
2 transcribed or altered in any way. The undersigned shall not give the recording(s) to another
3 person or allow the recording(s) to be used by another without the direct supervision of the
4 undersigned or his/her designee, without the prior written permission of the Presiding Judge of
5 the Marion County Circuit Court. The undersigned is responsible to make certain that anyone
6 else using the recording(s) does not permit the recording(s) to be copied, reproduced, borrowed,

8 legal work and ethical responsibilities of the undersigned. No one under the age of 18 is

15 The undersigned agrees and acknowledges that receipt of the recording(s) herein is made
16 under circumstances intended to secure maintenance of the court records; and as a condition of
17 this agreement, the undersigned agrees and promises as provided herein, and acknowledges that
18 “but for” the undersigned’s promises and this protective order, the recording(s) would not have
19 been provided to the undersigned by the MCTCA;

20 The allowance of this order and the grounds therefore are not intended to be the basis of
21 any claim of waiver or estoppels with regard to any further or separate request for recordings in
22 this or any other proceeding. Likewise, the court retains the right to determine appropriate use of
23 recordings in any special proceeding (e.g., Oregon State Bar investigations, Judicial Fitness
24 Commission proceedings or cases where there may otherwise be an overriding public interest
25 (e.g., regarding cases relating to matters where an attorney or the court acting in the course of
26 their court obligations itself may become a party, or is otherwise subject to appropriate scrutiny);

3 Judge reserves the right to grant or deny any requests for exceptions to this order without
4 affecting or waiving any other provisions of this order; and

5 The undersigned acknowledges that the terms of this stipulated order are enforceable by
6 the Court's contempt authority, and any violations of this order could result in the undersigned
7 being held in contempt.
