) ORDER REGARDING RULES FOR
) TRAINING AND CONTINUING
) EDUCATION FOR MULTNOMAH
) COUNTY ARBITRATORS

It is the policy of the Multnomah County Arbitration Commission that arbitrators placed on the Multnomah County Arbitrators' List (hereafter "List,") pursuant to ORS 13.090 should be trained in the law, procedure and ethics relating to the arbitration process. It is also the Commission's policy that arbitrators who conduct arbitrations shall have continuing training in such areas.

Therefore, in accordance with Multnomah County SLR 13.055(1),

1. All arbitrators serving on the List shall obtain training, as more particularly set forth in (6), *infra*.
2. Any qualified person seeking to be added to the List shall certify that he or she has obtained training, *infra*, prior to inclusion on the List.
3. All arbitrators currently on the List shall certify compliance with this training requirement no later than August 1, 2006.
4. Any person who continues as an active arbitrator on the List shall complete ongoing training of at least two (2) hours within every subsequent three (3) calendar years.
5. The Chief Dispute Resolution Judge, or designee, may waive, defer or extend the time for compliance with this Rule, upon application of the arbitrator for a substantial reason. An arbitrator failing to comply with these requirements who has not obtained such waiver, extension or deferral, may be removed from the List.
6. The training required of arbitrators on the List shall be approved in advance by the Multnomah County Arbitration Commission, and shall generally cover the statutory scheme, applicable rules, case law, and ethical considerations of arbitrators in court-annexed arbitration described in ORS 36.400 to 36.425.
