

Multnomah County Circuit Court eCourt Open Hours - eService for Criminal Filings



At the beginning of the session there will be a short presentation covering common eFiling mistakes and eFiling best practices followed by an overview of eService rules. We'll go over creating firm service contacts, adding and removing service contacts to a case, eServing, using appropriate certificates of service and tracking eService. The remaining time will be for Q &A.

Pre-registration is not required. Although this is focused on criminal eService, this session is open to everyone.

NOTE: eFiling is evolving. The focus has been on the "Filing" part of File & Serve. As most practitioners are now seasoned eFilers, the court can shift towards achieving compliance with the "Service" portion of File & Serve. The information presented here will help you gain familiarity with eService rules and resources and prepare you for the day the court starts enforcing eService rules in Chapter 21 of the Uniform Trial Court Rules, especially UTCR 21.100 et seq.
