Children in foster care are identified as Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN). But even with a high prevalence of chronic health conditions upon entering care, significant risk for long term health challenges, and medical recommendations for prioritized and specialized intervention, health care frequently fails to reach these children in a meaningful way. Mr. Martin will discuss the foster care population through the lenses of trauma exposure, AAP recommendations, health analytics, and system alignment.
