PROPOSED WORKPLAN**

Parental Decisions Workgroup - Kevin Aguirre, Chair

- Develop models for provision of education, mediation and legal services to IV-D clients interfacing with court and community resources

Education Workgroup - Maureen McKnight, Chair

- Develop protocol for providing educational and legal resource info to parents whose first contact with legal system is the IV-D agency
- Develop concept for educating public and professionals about Parent Locate Service
- Facilitate sharing of support calculation software amongst courts, agencies and facilitation programs
- Create OJD Deskbook on Child Support

Records Management Workgroup - Diane Pietzrak, Chair
