Pursuant to the authority in ORS 1.002, I HEREBY ORDER that the Oregon State Court Juvenile Justice Mental Health Task Force is established.

The purpose of the Task Force is to:

- (1) Review and assess the adequacy of mental health services provided to youth involved in the juvenile delinquency system in light of current best practices.
- (2) Identify whether any inadequacies exist, and if so, whether these are due to gaps in services, or underutilization of existing community services.
- (3) Develop and provide a report to the Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court containing Task Force findings and recommendations by January 31, 2016.
