

**REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT**  
Oregon Tort Claims Act  
2016 Annual Adjustment of the Statutory Liability Limits

Pursuant to ORS 30.271(4), 30.272(4), and 30.273(3), the Office of the State Court Administrator (OSCA) has followed the statutory methodology to calculate the annual adjustment to the limitations on liability of state and local public bodies for personal injury, death, and property damage or destruction. Based on these calculations, we propose to adjust the limitations as follows:

<b>Public Body</b>	<b>Claimant(s)</b>	<b>Claim</b>	<b>Adjusted Limit</b>
state	single	injury or death	\$ 2,073,600
state	multiple	injury or death	\$ 4,147,100
local	single	injury or death	\$ 691,200
local	multiple	injury or death	\$ 1,382,300
state or local	single	property damage or destruction	\$ 113,400
state or local	multiple	property damage or destruction	\$ 566,900

The public comment period on the proposed adjustments closes at 5:00 p.m. on May 2, 2016. OSCA will then finalize the adjustments and the new limitations will become effective on July 1, 2016. They will apply to all causes of action arising on or after July 1, 2016, and before July 1, 2017. OSCA makes these adjustments annually, as required by statute.
