CHIEF JUSTICE ORDER
No. 14-022

ORDER AUTHORIZING PILOT PROGRAM IN
THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT FOR
ELECTRONIC FILING OF PROPOSED
ORDERS AND JUDGMENTS

I HEREBY ORDER, pursuant to ORS 1.002 and UTCR 1.020, that:

1. UTCR 21.080(4), which permits the electronic filing of proposed orders and judgments through the Oregon circuit courts' electronic filing system, is currently held in abeyance pursuant to CJO 13-015 (dated March 26, 2013). That order prohibits the electronic filing of such documents absent further order from the Chief Justice.
2. Notwithstanding CJO 13-015, for purposes of a pilot program, proposed orders and judgments may be electronically filed through the Oregon circuit courts' electronic filing system for cases filed in the Eighteenth Judicial District (Clatsop County), as of the date of this order.
3. UTCR 21.050(2)(a), which permits the electronic filing of applications for fee waiver or deferral through the Oregon circuit courts' electronic filing system, is currently held in abeyance pursuant to CJO 13-015. That order prohibits the electronic filing of such applications absent further order from the Chief Justice.
4. The prohibition in CJO 13-015 of electronic filing of applications for fee waiver or deferral remains in effect for the Eighteenth Judicial District and all other judicial districts using the electronic filing system.
5. This order takes effect on May 5, 2014.
