Clackamas County DUII Court

Welcome to the Clackamas County DUII Court Program. You have been offered the chance to take part in this program as an opportunity to change your life and receive help to overcome the wreckage of addiction. This is an intensive program that is designed to help you achieve and maintain sobriety. Although DUII Court is a wonderful opportunity, you should not make the choice to enter lightly. There are things you will need to think about before making your decision about whether to enter this program:

Cost: You will be expected to pay for your treatment costs, probation supervision fees, electronic monitoring fees, the cost of the Victim Impact Panel, and all statutorily required financial obligations (which may be suspended if you successfully complete this program). These costs must be paid after a DUII conviction whether or not you enter the DUII Court.

- **Time:** You will spend a great deal of time in treatment, attending 12-step meetings, and making court appearances, etc. You must be willing to commit the amount of time necessary for all of these activities.
- **Expectation:** Commitment is a must! Again, this is an intensive program that is designed to change your life by helping you obtain and maintain sobriety. You will be expected to commit to that concept fully and fulfill everything that is required of you if you wish to take part in this program.

The advantages of being a DUII Court participant include the following benefits:

- Less jail
- Dismissal of fines and fees in the case(s) placed with the DUII Court. (Upon successful completion of both the program and the 18 months bench probation).
- Focus on Treatment
- Opportunity to lead a better life, free of substance abuse!

If you decide to enter this program, please carefully read all of the documents contained in this packet. Upon intake you must be truthful in your answers!

DUII Entry To Do List

The following must be done BEFORE entry in DUII Court. Failure to accomplish these requirements may delay your entry into DUII Court.

- Review this entire packet. Make sure you understand everything that will be required of you.
- Make any necessary arrangements if you anticipate spending any amount of time in custody.

Once you have entered the program you will need to do the following within 24 hours of your release from custody:

- If you are released from the jail to serve the remainder of your sentence on EHD, you must go to BI Direct at 402 Beaver Creek Rd. Ste. 105, Oregon City, OR 97045. 503-722-1222.
- You must report to Community Corrections for an intake appointment within 24 hours of either: (1) being set up on EHD or (2) completing and being released from custody. Community Corrections is located at 1024 Main St., Oregon City, OR 97045. You must contact probation officer Jason Ridgeway at 503-723-2927.
- Once you have checked in with Community Corrections and spoken with Jason, you must report to SCRAM/Vigilnet to be placed on an Alcohol monitoring bracelet. (If you are on EHD you will not need to report to SCRAM). The offices are in Oregon City and Portland. Jason Ridgeway or Dawn Haskett can direct you to the appropriate office to report to depending on the day of the week.
- After you complete your intake with Community Corrections and report to SCRAM, you must contact Dawn Haskett to set up a new participant orientation. If you have not already been directed to see her at a specific time, please contact her by phone at 503-655-8495.

Driving Restrictions

You must agree and abide by the conditions listed on this form as a non-negotiable condition of your participation in the program. Please fill out all information and initial the rules to show that you understand.

Clackamas County DUII Court Rules

Please initial in the space before each rule to show that you understand it. These rules will be enforced by the following agencies that make up the DUII Court Team: (1) State Court, (2) Clackamas County Sheriff's Department, (3) Clackamas County District Attorney's Office, (4) Defense Attorney, and (5) Clackamas County Community Corrections.

- _____ I understand that I must plead guilty as a condition of entering into the DUII court program and may serve a jail sanction to be accepted.
- _____ I understand that I will be immediately terminated from the DUII court program for obtaining a new DUII while in the program.
- _____ I agree to pay all fines and fees if revoked from the DUII court program, but I understand that these fines and fees will be forgiven upon successful completion of the program and successful completion of the follow-up 18 month bench probation.
- _____ I will not engage in any criminal activity.
- _____ I will not own, possess, or drive any motor vehicle and I will sell any vehicle I currently own.
- _____ I understand that I must arrange for a reliable form of transportation for meetings, treatment, court appearances, etc.
- _____ I will not use, possess, or be in the presence of, any illegal drugs, alcohol or drug paraphernalia.
- _____ I agree to take Antabuse if I am medically able and if directed by my P.O.
- _____ I will not use any prescriptions without the written consent of a medical provider and I will not use any prescription medications that are not mine.
- _____ I agree to be tested for the presence of any drug at any time by a police officer, probation officer, my treatment provider, the Court or any agency designated by the Court.
- _____ I understand that if I fail to submit a UA or any other type of drug test when scheduled or directed it will be considered positive.
- _____ I will not tamper with drug tests or in any way alter or change my bodily fluids in an attempt to change the outcome of a drug test. Doing so is grounds for termination from the program and the resulting UA will be considered dirty.
- _____ I will submit to a polygraph if the Court, treatment provider, or my P.O. requests it.
- _____ I must attend all treatment and other ordered sessions.
- _____ I agree not to enter or frequent any establishment whose primary income is derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages and I shall not frequent places where narcotics are used, sold or kept.
- _____ I understand that tardiness to treatment, court, or any other ordered session can be counted as an absence and will be sanctioned at the Court's discretion.
- _____ I agree not to have sexual relationships with anyone in the DUII Court program.
- _____ I understand that I must provide verification of employment by showing a pay stub before I am eligible for graduation. Without pay stubs I understand that I will be considered unemployed.
- _____ I understand that I must attend all AA/NA meetings or approved 12-step program meetings as ordered by DUII Court personnel and that my attendance at all of these meetings must be verifiable by the DUII Court Team.
- _____ I agree to obtain a substance abuse evaluation as directed by the probation officer and follow through with any treatment recommendations, including inpatient treatment and comply with all follow-up treatment. I will be responsible for the evaluation fee and I will successfully complete and pay for any treatment recommendation by the evaluator.
- _____ I understand that I must submit proof of a GED or high school diploma to graduate from the DUII Court Program.
- _____ I understand that I must keep the court advised of my current mailing address at all times and allow DUII Court treatment clinicians, probation officers, and police officers to make home visits as necessary.

ELECTRONIC HOME DETENTION (EHD)/SCRAM

You are not required to have a land line in your residence to use EHD or SCRAM. If you do have a land line, you can download data from your SCRAM bracelet at home instead of reporting to one of two SCRAM offices twice a week.

EHD Costs and Information:

You must pay in the form of a Money Order, Visa, Master Card or Certified Check. No personal checks or cash are accepted.

To use a cellular bracelet the cost is \$19 a day. To use a land line the cost is \$17 a day. There is a \$20 UA fee and a \$30 install fee.

Payment is handled on an individual basis.

You may work up to 60 hours per week while on EHD.

You will be allowed to go to work, doctor, dentist, AA, NA (or related groups), treatment program, church, grocery shopping, child visits and court ordered appointments.

You must check-in at BI at least once per week to prepare a schedule.

You must comply with all terms and conditions set forth by BI as a condition of your participation in the DUII Court program.

ELECTRONIC HOME DETENTION (EHD)/SCRAM Cont:

SCRAM/Vigilnet Costs and Information:

Vigilnet provides the SCRAM services and will accept payment in any form.

There is an installation cost of \$45 and a minimum cost of \$9 a day for those who are unemployed. Those who are not unemployed will be set up for payment on a sliding scale. The first two weeks of services is typically due at time services are rendered. However, Vigilnet will work with you if you show good faith.

You are not restricted in any way when you are on SCRAM. You may come and go from any appointments, meetings, court, etc. freely.

If you do not have a land line, you must report to either the Portland or Oregon City SCRAM office twice per week to download your bracelet.

If your bracelet requires any maintenance, you must report to the Portland or Oregon City SCRAM office within 48 hours of reporting a problem.

You must comply with all terms and conditions set forth by Vigilnet/SCRAM as a condition of your participation in the DUII Court program.
