Time to First Jurisdiction Finding

What it measures: % of dependency cases with a jurisdiction finding within 60 days of filing

Starting Event: Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

Closing Event: Jurisdiction or Dismissal Judgment or Order

Time to Jurisdiction on Both Parents

What it measures: % of

dependency cases with jurisdiction on both parents within 60 days of

filing

Starting Event: Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

Closing Event: Jurisdiction or dismissal judgment(s) related to <u>all</u> causes of action on the case

Time in Care

What it measures: The average length of time that a child spends in care.

Starting Event: Entered Care event as provided

by DHS.

Closing Event: Entering of the Left Care (by form of permanency) event

as provided by DHS.

Time to First Permanency Hearing, Looking Back

What it measures: Days between the filing of a dependency petition and the first permanency hearing

Starting Event: Petition – Dependency (PTDP)

Closing Event: Final day of a hearing with a *Hearing Type* of **Hearing** – **Permanency (HGPE)** and a *Result* of **Held** or **Court-Appointed Attorney**

Time to Subsequent Permanency Hearing

What it measures: Days between

What it measures: % of TPR cases adjudicated within 182 days of filing Starting Event: Petition –

Closing Events:

- Judgment Terminating Parental Rights

Time to Termination or Relinquishment of Parental Rights

What it measures: Days between the filing of a dependency petition and the date at which the rights of all parents on the dependency case have been terminated or relinquished

Starting Event: Petition - Dependency

Closing Event: Judgment – Terminating Parental Rights or Release – Surrender on TPR cases for each parent on the dependency case (party records for both Juvenile and Parent parties must match those on the dependency case)
