- Local process:
 - Setting hearing
 - Early appointment of attorneys
 - Timely discovery
 - Parent engagement and safety planning
 - First visit within 48 hours



What Judges Can Do

- Appoint a lawyer for the child
- Appoint a CASA for the child
- Ask the DHS caseworker about child safety
- Ask to have the child appear in court or write a letter to the judge
- Review CRB reports for safety info
