

JCIP Model Forms Summary of Changes Effective January 2020

(1) New Protective Custody Order.

A new order is available to respond to requests to take a child into protective custody filed under ORS 419B.150. These are requests filed before a shelter hearing when the Department of Human Services (DHS) seeks to take the child into custody but the case does not meet the emergency statutory criteria to remove the child without a court order. The order was developed to be consistent with legislative changes made by House Bill 2849 (2019), which goes into effect on January 1, 2020. DHS has also developed a new statewide declaration consistent with the new statutory criteria that will be used to make these requests.

(2) Notice Regarding Sex Offender Registration.

A revised version of the form that must be provided to a youth when the court orders him or her to report as a sex offender is available. The revised notice clarifies that the youth must report within 10 days of the court's order requiring him or her to report under ORS 163A.030. ORS 163A.025(1)(a).
