



Text Notifications for Court Hearings

How to Sign Up

The court will sign you up automatically if they have a cell phone number connected to your case.

How the Text Notifications Work

You will get a text when your hearing is:

- Scheduled.
- Rescheduled.
- Canceled.

You also will get reminder texts seven days before the hearing and one day before the hearing.

You will get texts in the evenings only.

- Texts are sent between 5:30 and 9 p.m. PST.
- Even if your hearing information changes multiple times during the day, we will only text you one time in the evening with the most recent update.

Important Things to Remember

It is your responsibility to attend the hearings on the correct day and time, even if you don't get the texts.

- The text notifications are meant to help you remember when to appear. They are not legally required.
- Even if the notification system or your phone do not work correctly, you are still responsible for attending your hearing.
- If you miss your hearing, you cannot use excuses like "I didn't get the text" or "the text was wrong." The court will not accept these as valid reasons for missing your hearing.

Make sure the court has your current cell phone number.

- If your number changes, please tell your attorney and the court so that you keep getting the text notifications.
