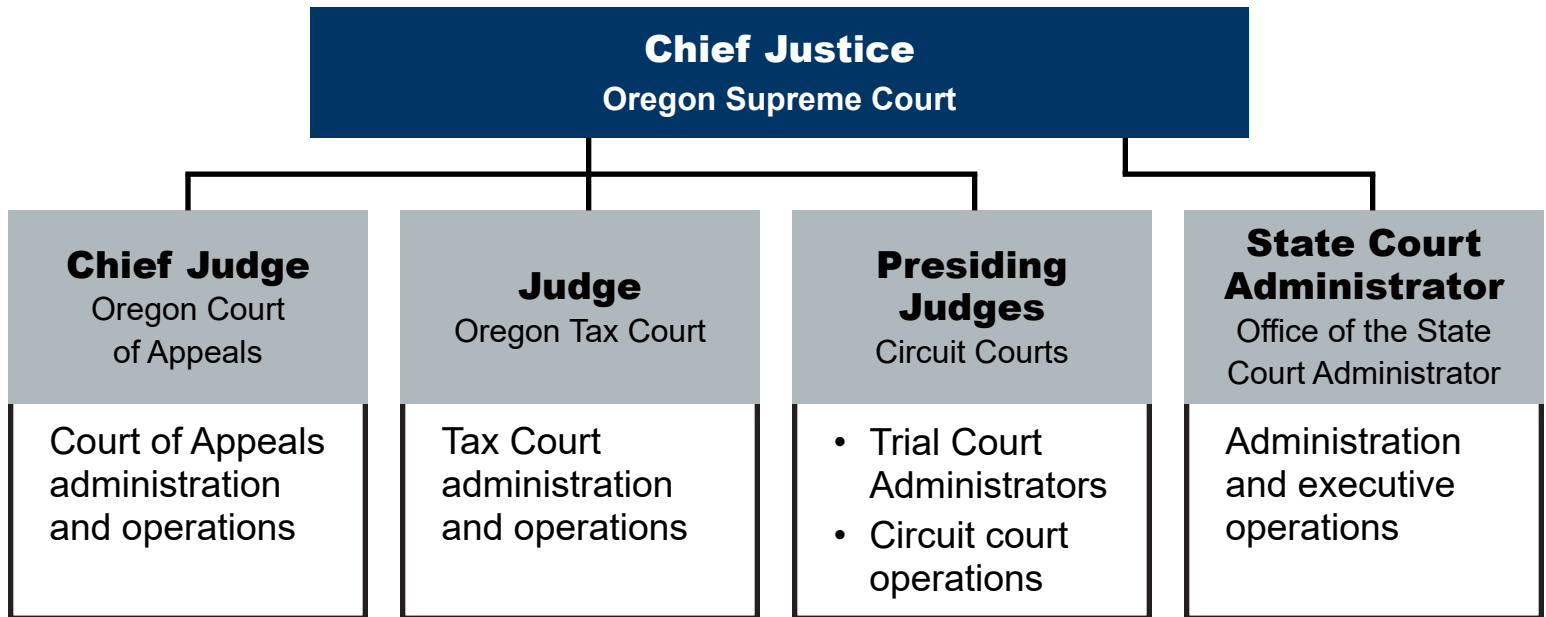

(1 more judge to be added in July 2025)

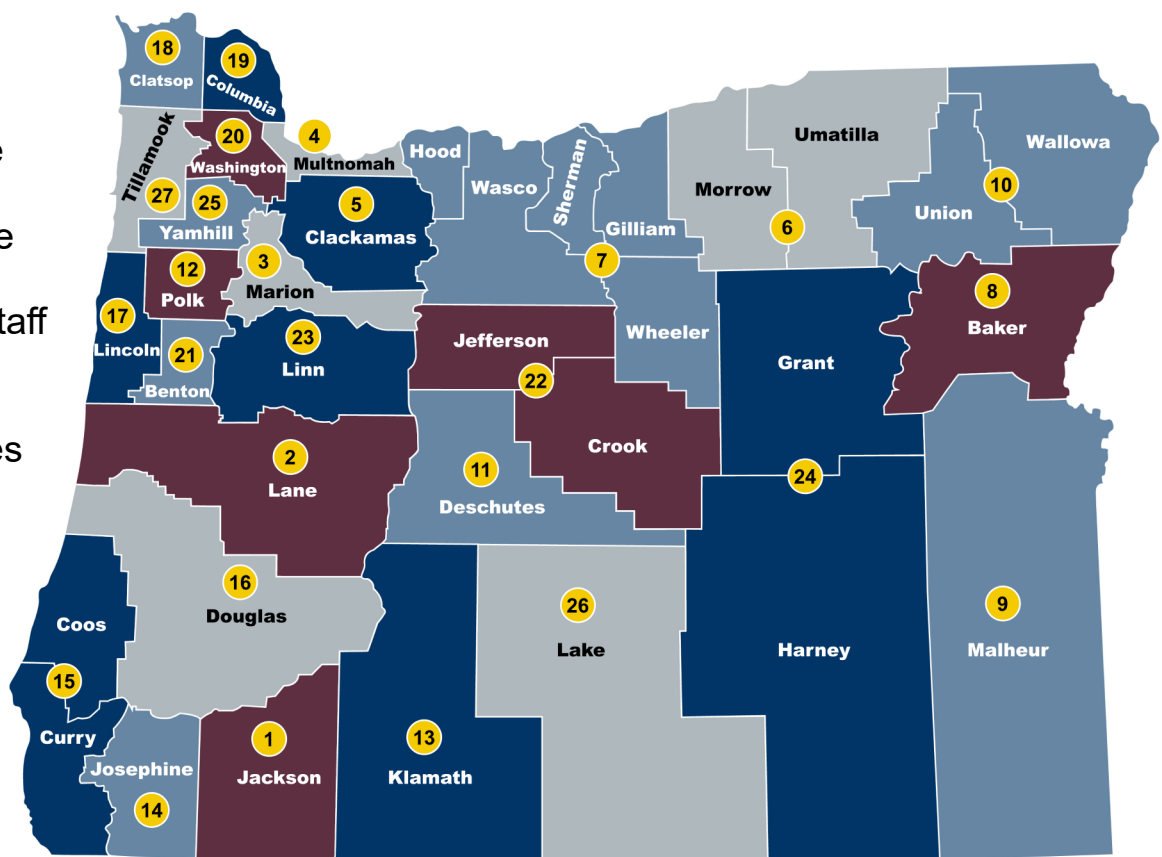

Oregon's state courts

- 27 judicial districts: some contain one county, and some have more than one
- 181 circuit court judges (1 more to be added in July 2025)
- About 1,800 court staff
- Serving 4.24 million people in Oregon
- About 583,000 cases each year.
