

## Oregon Complex Litigation Court

### Procedures

- A presiding judge's request that a case be considered for acceptance into the Oregon Complex Litigation Court (OCLC) shall be sent to Kim Blanding, Office of the State Court Administrator, and shall include the following:
  - A statement that all parties presently involved in the case agree to assignment of the case to the OCLC.
  - A statement identifying the special needs, facts, and issues of the case.
  - All proposed affidavits against judges on the OCLC that the parties intend to assert.
    - Each party may submit up to two proposed affidavits, as allowed by statute.
    - OCLC judges will be listed on the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) website.
- The managing panel will make a decision on whether to accept a case into the OCLC, as well as on any judge assignment, within two weeks of receipt of a request. Ms. Blanding will send information on the panel's decisions to the parties, the presiding judge, and the judge assigned to the case.
