

## What Proceedings are Happening at Clackamas County Circuit Court?

- Court Proceedings that *Generally* Must Occur in Person as indicated per CJO/PJOs

**Note:** *Remote hearings are being scheduled for many of these matters. If the matter you are appearing on has not been scheduled as a remote hearing and you would like to appear remotely, please contact the court to make that request at least 2 day in advance of the hearing.*

- ❖ Bench and Jury Criminal Trials Necessary to Comply with Speedy Trial Requirements
  - ❖ Criminal Proceedings when Defendant is in Custody (See PJO 2020-13, 2020-18 and PJO 2020-20).
    - Arraignments
    - Probable Cause Hearings
    - Release hearings
    - Probation Violation Hearings
    - Plea Hearings
    - Sentencing Hearings
    - Any Hearings that will Directly Lead to Release of Defendant or Case Resolution
  - ❖ In-custody Juvenile Delinquency Adjudication
  - ❖ Civil Commitment Hearings (Mostly Occurring Remotely)
  - ❖ Grand Jury Proceedings or Preliminary Hearings for Felony Indictments
- Other Court Proceedings. These Proceedings are Dependent on Sufficient Staff and Available Courtrooms to Allow Social Distancing, and if Technology is Available to Allow them to Occur. *Generally* Many of These Will Occur Remotely Unless Motion/Declaration/Proposed Order is Filed to Appear in Person Showing Prejudice.
    - ❖ Bench Trials in Any Case, Except FED Cases.
    - ❖ Criminal Proceedings:
      - Case Management Hearings and Docket Hearings.
      - Out-of-custody Arraignments on Citations Within 30 Days of Issuance.

- Hearings on Out-of-custody Case Resolutions, Including Pleas, Change of Plea, and Sentencing.
- Judicial Settlement Conferences.
  
- ❖ Civil Proceedings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Family Law and Protective Order Proceedings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Juvenile Dependency Hearings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Juvenile Delinquency Proceedings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Probate Proceedings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Specialty Court Proceedings: All Matters.
  
- ❖ Proceedings Involving Quarantine Under ORS 42.123 and ORS 433.133, or Isolation of Contaminated Property Under ORS 433.142.
  
- ❖ Habeas Corpus Proceedings Under ORS 34.370.
  
- Ancillary Proceedings Occurring Outside the Courtroom. These Generally Occur Remotely.
  - ❖ Mediations/Arbitrations/ Settlement Conferences

## **What Proceedings are Not Happening at Clackamas County Circuit Court?**

- Jury Trials, With the Exception of Those Allowed as Listed Above.
