NOTICE TO PLAINTIFFS FILING FED (EVICTION) AND FORECLOSURE CASES

On June 30, 2020, HB 4204 and HB 4213 became effective. The bills provide for a moratorium on certain residential and commercial eviction cases and foreclosures.

- If you file your complaint, your filing fee will not be refunded even if the court dismisses your case.
