It is the policy of the Clackamas County Arbitration Commission that arbitrators placed on the Clackamas County Court Arbitrator's List ("the List") pursuant to ORS 13.090 must implement practices and procedures consistent with the Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS), the Uniform Trial Court Rules (UTCR), and the Clackamas County Supplemental Local Rules (SLR). Arbitrators on the List must also maintain their professional status in good standing with the Oregon State Bar (OSB), its Ethics Commission (EC), and/or the Judicial Ethics Commission (JEC).

THEREFORE, in accordance with Clackamas County SLR 13.091(1), and consistent with the consensus of the ARBITRATION COMMISSION for the Clackamas County Court expressed at the July 28, 2014 meeting:

- 1. Any arbitrator on the List who does not comply with ORS, UTCR, or SLR in executing their duties as an Arbitrator may be subject to removal from the List, in the sole discretion of the Arbitration Commission Chair.
- 2. Any arbitrator on the List who is subject to any form of disciplinary action by the OSB, the EC, or the JEC, whether formal or informal, is required to disclose the fact and nature of the disciplinary action to the Clackamas County Arbitration Commission Chair within ten (10) days of the action being taken.
- 3. Any arbitrator on the List who has been subject to any disciplinary action by the OSB, the EC, or the JEC, shall be suspended from assignments to Clackamas County Court arbitrations pending review of the individual circumstances of the discipline by the Clackamas County Arbitration Commission. Disciplinary action may also result in temporary or permanent removal from the List, at the sole discretion of the Arbitration Commission Chair.
