I issue this ORDER pursuant to ORS 1.060(3), including extensions of statutory time limitations pursuant to ORS 174.120(2)(c), due to the following:

1. On October 21, 2026, staff in the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Tax Court, and the circuit courts will be participating in both statewide training programs and other local training.
2. A statewide court closure is necessary to provide the opportunity for statewide and other system trainings, although electronic filing will remain available.

I therefore ORDER as follows:

1. The Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, the Tax Court, and all circuit courts will be closed on October 21, 2026, within the meaning of ORS 1.060(3) and ORS 174.120(2)(c), for the purposes of filing documents, staffing public counters, and answering phones and email inquiries.
2. All Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Tax Court, and circuit court facilities will be closed to the public on October 21, 2026.
3. This order declares a closure, for purposes of the extensions of statutory time limitations described in ORS 174.120(2)(c).
4. The closure described in paragraph 1 is not a closure for any employees of the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, the Appellate Court Services Division, the Tax Court, or the circuit courts.
