


6. Upon successful completion of the court-required class, the non-professional fiduciary shall file a certificate of completion with the Court stating the date and time the class was taken as well as the provider of the class.
7. Upon a showing of good cause, a non-professional fiduciary may request a waiver of the requirements of this Order. The request must be made by motion, supported by affidavit, and filed within fifteen (15) days of receipt of notice.
8. The Court may, in its discretion, require a non-professional fiduciary to retake the class.
9. Failure to timely comply with this Order may result in removal of the non-professional fiduciary by the Court.
