In the course of a juvenile court case, a referral letter submitted to the evaluator for purposes of evaluation, and/or a Child's or Parent's medical, psychological and/or Amani evaluation is frequently received by the parties.

IT IS ORDERED THAT while attorneys may provide their clients access to such materials in the presence of the attorney or the attorney's staff consistently with the attorney's ethical obligations, attorneys will not provide separate copies of such materials for clients to possess outside the presence of the attorney or staff member. The Assistant Attorney General is exempted from this provision when representing the Department of Human Services (DHS) due to the latter's statutory obligations as the guardian of the child.

When a Parent or Child is self-represented, that party shall be entitled to review any of the materials referenced above in the presence of the staff of the Judge of the Case, to take notes about these materials, and to have access to a copy of such materials during hearing or trial when requested.

Attorneys for Parents or Children may provide a copy of the materials referenced above to experts retained to assist in the evaluation of or planning for the Child or Parent who is the subject of the materials. Such experts are thereafter prohibited from further distribution or sharing of the provided report except as ordered by the Court.
