THIS MATTER having come before the court upon Chief Justice Order 21-025, Order Establishing Updated Directives Relating to Court Operations:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED beginning July 20, 2021, in all hearings, all parties may appear either in person or via video conferencing using the court's WebEx video conferencing tool, without prior permission from the court. The following exceptions apply:

- 1) Parties must appear in person when personal physical appearance is required by statute.
- 2) Defendants must appear in person for arraignment if they have not been previously booked and fingerprinted.
- 3) All parties must appear in person for jury trials.
- 4) All parties must appear for court trials unless approved by order of the court.

Remote appearances may be allowed by written order of the court upon a motion of a party prior to the hearing.

Any hearing already scheduled with a Notice of Hearing indicating it is to be held remotely remains in effect.
