This matter comes before the Circuit Court as an administrative function of this Court.

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 3.275 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over certain family-related matters after making a determination that conditions in the judicial district make it desirable to concentrate jurisdiction over all or part of family and family-related matters in the circuit court, the circuit court by its own order shall exercise jurisdiction over any or all of the matters described in ORS 3.260(2) on and after July 1 next following entry of the order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that jurisdiction over change of name under ORS 33.410 is removed from the Grant County Court judicial functions and beginning July 1, 2019 jurisdiction resides with the Circuit Court of Grant County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the name change records now in the custody of the Grant County Court be transferred to the custody of the Grant County Circuit Court.

This completes the transfer of all family-related matters under ORS 3.260.

Copies of this order are simultaneously filed with the Oregon Supreme Court and the Grant County Court.
