
IN THE MATTER OF FACE COVERINGS  
DURING JURY TRIALS

PRESIDING JUDGE ORDER  
NO. 21- 15

Based on the authority granted to Presiding Judges in paragraph seven (7) of Chief Justice Order 21-028 dated July 29, 2021, it is hereby ORDERED:

- 1) All participants in any jury trial conducted in-person in the First Judicial District shall wear an appropriate protective face covering during the entire trial.
- 2) The removal of face coverings by fully vaccinated persons as permitted by paragraphs 4(a)(1) of CJO 21-028 shall not be allowed during an in-person jury trial.
- 3) A judge presiding over an in-person jury trial may allow temporary removal of face coverings as permitted by 4(a)(2)(A) of CJO 21-028.
