Process & Protocols

COURT TIME

Restraining Order initial petitions are heard at Family Court Ex Parte time daily.

The court session

begins at 8:30 am daily (unless otherwise changed due to court availability)

ELIGIBLE CAES

INITIAL PETITIONS ONLY

FAPA - Family Abuse Prevention Act Restraining Orders

EPPDAPA - Elder Abuse and Persons With Disabilities Act Restraining Orders

SAPO - Sexual Abuse Prevention Act Orders

CALL

CALL to notify that a faxed restraining order is coming in

Leave a voicemail if after business hours.

IN COURT

The court will call Petitioner

AT THE NUMBER ON THE COVERSHEET

within 1/2 hour of the court session.

PHONE NUMBERS

The phone number on the coversheet will only be used to contact the Petitioner for the initial hearing.

Later contact will be made to the phone number listed on the court paperwork.

COPIES - FOR PETITIONER

The court will process copies for the Petitioner (person filing) IMMEDIATELY based on the designation made on the cover sheet.

COPY OPTIONS

Option 1

Email copy - to email address on Coversheet.

Option 2

Petitioner comes to Family Court to pick up a hard copy (within 3 days)

SERVICE

Service copies will be routed based on the designation made on the Coversheet.

COPIES FOR SERVICE

Paperwork has address IN OREGON for Resp...

Court handles service and sends to Sheriff's Department.

Resp. NOT in Oregon or no address...

Court mails service copies to Petitioner.
