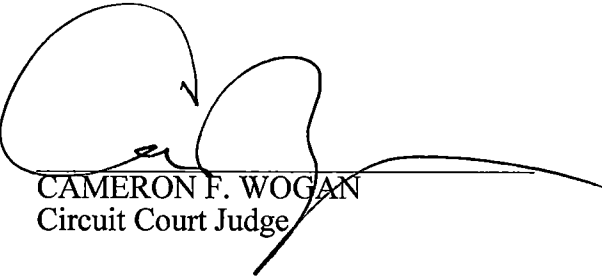
II. Guidelines for Oral Arguments for Phase 1B Motions and Phase 1C Comments.
