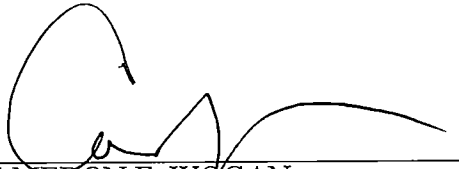
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22 **II. Guidelines for Oral Arguments for Phase 1C Motions.**
