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- I. **Status Conference.** The Case Management Committee reported at the January 10, 2024, status conference that some parties are considering whether to seek to stay the adjudication of the non-tribal claims pending resolution of the tribal claims that were remanded to the OWRD director. As discussed at that conference, the court has scheduled another status conference for Wednesday, February 7, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. to determine whether a stay will be requested and to discuss more generally the next phases of the adjudication. 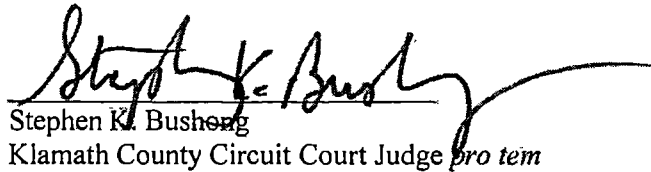
**Case Management Committee.** The Case Management Committee should confer in advance of the status conference regarding any requests to stay, the process for adjudicating

the non-tribal claims, and any other procedural recommendations the committee may have.

The committee should submit its recommendations at or before the status conference.

- III. Deadline for Any Motions to Stay Adjudication on Non-Tribal Claims.** As discussed at the January 10 status conference, any party requesting to stay the adjudication of non-tribal claims pending resolution of the tribal claims that were remanded to the OWRD director must be filed no later than 12:00 noon on February 7, 2024. If any such motion is filed, the court will set at the February 7 status conference a briefing and argument schedule for motions to stay. If no such motion is filed, the parties and the court will discuss at the February 7 status conference the next steps in the adjudication of the non-tribal claims and any other procedural matters recommended by the Case Management Committee.
