1. INTRODUCTION. This proceeding is referred to as "The Klamath Adjudication." This case management order will be mailed to those listed on the current service list provided by the court on May 8th, 2013.

2. ORDER REGARDING SERVICE OF DOCUMENTS. This order provides the procedure for service of documents when service is required on all parties to this case.

CURRENT SERVICE LIST The court will maintain a current service list on its web site and in hard copy. Parties and addresses will be added, deleted, or corrected when the following occurs:

- (a). When the court receives notice that an attorney will accept service of documents for client(s) in which case the clients will be deleted from the list and the attorney added.
- (b). When it is obvious that there are duplicate listings of the same person or entity on the list, the duplicates will be deleted.
- (c). When items are returned to the court as non-deliverable, the person or entity and address will be deleted from the list.
- (d). When a person or entity gives notice that its address, representative(s), or other service information should be changed or deleted, the requested changes will be made.
- (e). When the court determines that a change should be made in the interests of justice, that change will be made.

SUFFICIENT SERVICE It will be a sufficient certificate of service if a party states that they have served those listed on the current service list provided by the court on ____ [date] ____.

1 THE RECORD The court will keep a record of all service lists in effect over time and the
2 reasons for changes to them.

3 3. ORDER SETTING INITIAL HEARING An order setting the initial hearing for March 3,
4 2014 was entered by the court and a copy of that order will be mailed with this order to those
5 listed on the current service list provided by the court on May 8th, 2013.



28 14 days of the time they file their Petition for Stay or Request to be Heard. A reply memorandum, if any,
must be filed within 7 days of the service of the responding memorandum.
