THIS MATTER having come before the court on its own motion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the initial hearing and time to file exceptions set for May 30th, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. is set over to September 3, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.

The hearing is set over because it will result in less costly and more fair proceedings for the following reasons:

a). If set over, the Court will likely have implemented the Odyssey electronic court system for this case. The Court could then accept filings in this case in electronic format

b). If set over, the Court will likely have scanned all documents from the Water Resources Department record and they will be available in digital format.

c). The State filed the Amended and Corrected Findings of Fact and Order of Determination (ACFFOD) on April 10th, 2014 and if the initial hearing is set over, the parties will have more time to review that document.

d). After allowing time for comments or objections, the proposed order, form, and instructions submitted by the case management committee may be adopted by the Court and mailed to the parties at the soonest on or about May 12, 2014 . If the initial hearing is set over, the parties will have more time to understand and utilize these documents.

- A draft of a cover letter the State anticipates sending out with copies of the amended and corrected findings of fact and order of determination (ACFFOD)


