IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT E-FILING

- eFilings are being routed through Jackson County. This means that screens you see during the eFiling process, as well as receipts and acceptance emails, will have the name Jackson or Jackson County on them and not Klamath or Klamath County.
- This case already exists within the system. You should NEVER select New Case when attempting to eFile into the Klamath Basin Adjudication case even if this is the first time you are using the eFiling system or filing into this case.
- Tyler Technologies provides all technical Support. If you need support and Tyler asks you what court you are filing into you are filing into Jackson County.
- If you have a court business process question you need to contact Klamath County Circuit Court (e.g. What do I call this document? When can I file? When is the next hearing? etc.)



ELECTRONIC FILING

You can electronically file your documents on the case by using Odyssey File and Serve (OJD's eFiling solution). You can access File and Serve at this web address: <u>http://oregon.tylerhost.net/</u>

Registering for File and Serve

Electronic filing is free; however, you must register to use the system. Click *Register Now*, from the File and Serve homepage to begin.

File and Serve will walk you through the rest of the registration process.

Electronic Filing into the Klamath Basin Adjudication Case

After logging into the system, File and Serve will direct you to your *Workspace*. From your *Workspace* input the case number in the *Case Number field* and click *Go*.



Filing a First Appearance

To file your exception, select the filing code "Objection – OB". The *Optional Services box* will appear below the *Reference Number field*. Select the fee "Civil – First Responding Party (Default/Declaratory) (\$252)" and click *Add* \rightarrow .

Under the Documents section, select Click to Browse and attach your exception document.

If you are filing additional documents with your exception, select *Add Another Filing*. This will allow you to add as many documents as necessary to your eFiling envelope.

ONLINE DOCUMENT ACCESS

You can access the circuit court's case record online through the Oregon eCourt Case Information (OECI) System. Access to OECI is through a paid subscription to the Oregon Judicial Case Information Network (OJCIN). Only members of the Oregon State Bar and Designated Governmental Users (and their staff) who have subscriptions can access documents through the system at this time.

Please note there is a cost for both signing up (\$100) and a monthly subscription fee (\$35).

Accessing the Klamath Basin Adjudication Case Record

Once you have a subscription, you access the Klamath Basin Adjudication case through OECI This case information is not in OJIN.

- 2. Select Oregon eCourt Case Information (OECI) from the drop-down list and click Sign In.

3. After signing into the system, select Search Civil, Family, and Probate Case Records.

- 5. Select the blue hyperlink to access the Register of Actions.
 - a. Entries on the Register of Actions that are in blue contain documents; click the entry name to go to the documents screen.
