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THIS MATTER having come before the Court based on reasons to doubt defendant's fitness to proceed by reason of incapacity as described in ORS 161.360, the Court orders that the Lane County Mental Health Program Director or the director's designee consult with the defendant to determine whether services and supervision necessary to safely restore the defendant's fitness to proceed are available in the community.

Consistent with ORS 161.370(9)(b), within five judicial days after receipt of this Order, the Lane County Mental Health Program Director or designee shall:

1. Consult with the defendant and with any local entity that would be responsible for supervising the defendant if the defendant were to be released in the community to determine whether services and supervision necessary to safely allow the defendant to gain or regain to proceed are available in the community, and
2. Provide the Court and parties with recommendations from the consultation.

The District Attorney, defense attorney and Lane County Sheriff's Office shall provide all non-privileged pertinent information about defendant to the Lane County Mental Health Program Director or director's designee upon request.

In addition, the Oregon State Hospital Forensic Service shall provide its reports and updates, if any, regarding defendant to the Lane County Mental Health Program Director or director's designee upon request.
