



)	PROCEEDINGS UNDER LEVEL 2 RESTRICTIONS

The court previously issued Presiding Judge Orders (PJOs) describing court operations in civil, criminal, family, juvenile and probate cases under Level 2 restrictions in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and the move into the new courthouse. The court continues to look for opportunities to serve the public by expanding services that it can safely provide during the COVID-19 pandemic consistent with the Level 2 restrictions imposed by Chief Justice Order (CJO) 20-016, and will conduct proceedings using remote means where possible and authorized to limit the potential for exposure. The court has concluded that it can resume its small claims docket shortly after the move into the new courthouse.

Accordingly, in addition to the proceedings expressly allowed under previously-issued CJOs and PJOs, the court may conduct under Level 2 restrictions the following proceedings: beginning October 19, 2020, all proceedings in small claims cases.
