) DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

In addition to the proceedings described in Presiding Judge Order No. 20DR00000 regarding family law, juvenile and probate proceedings, the following proceedings will also be held while Level 3 restrictions are in effect:

1. In Juvenile cases: Case management conferences in sex offender and waiver cases shall proceed as scheduled and shall be conducted by remote means.
2. In Probate cases: Petitions or motions for appointment, termination or extension of temporary guardianships, temporary conservatorships and emergency protection orders shall be scheduled and heard while Level 3 restrictions are in effect. All other probate matters will be postponed until after Level 3 restrictions are lifted.
3. In Family Law cases: Parties seeking to modify child and/or spousal support shall file a motion and affidavit. Once received, the Court will issue an Order to Show Cause in the form attached hereto. The Court will notify the parties of a date for a hearing once Level 3 restrictions are no longer in effect. Once the parties receive notice of the hearing date, they shall, within 30 days, file a Uniform Support Declaration.
