The Court finds that ORS 419C.370 provides that the Juvenile Court may enter an order directing that all cases involving violation of a law or ordinance relating to the use or operation of a motor vehicle, boating laws or game laws be waived to the criminal court provided the criminal court notify the Juvenile Court of the filing of each such case prior to a hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, the Court ORDERS, pursuant to ORS 419C.370 and the violation being within the venue of the criminal court per ORS 153.036:

The following violations are waived to the criminal court:

- 1) violations defined in the Oregon Vehicle Code and relating to the use or operation of a motor vehicle
- 2) boating violations
- 3) game violations.

The waiver under this Order is subject to notice to the Juvenile Court prior to a hearing. The Juvenile Court may direct that a case be returned to the Juvenile court for further proceedings. The files of any case filed in criminal court and returned to the Juvenile Court shall be sealed.

Records of cases waived pursuant to this Order are Juvenile records for purposes of expunction under ORS 419A.260-271.
