ESTABLISHING THE LENGTH
OF JURY SERVICE

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to ORS 10.105, that the length of the jury service term and the frequency of summoning jurors to the court for each day of court business shall be for two days of jury service, provided however that the term as a juror shall be extended to the discharge of the juror by the court upon completion of the matter if selected as a juror and sworn to preside over a trial. This standard term does not apply for jurors selected to be grand jurors, jurors specially summoned for specific actions or proceedings, or jurors otherwise ordered to serve a different term by a judge of the court.

This order takes effect immediately and supersedes the length of jury service established in Presiding Judge Order 2101-30000 signed on December 14, 2021.
